Wire brushing accentuates the grain for a matte, textured finish that's both refined and rustic — adding warmth, durability, and timeless character.

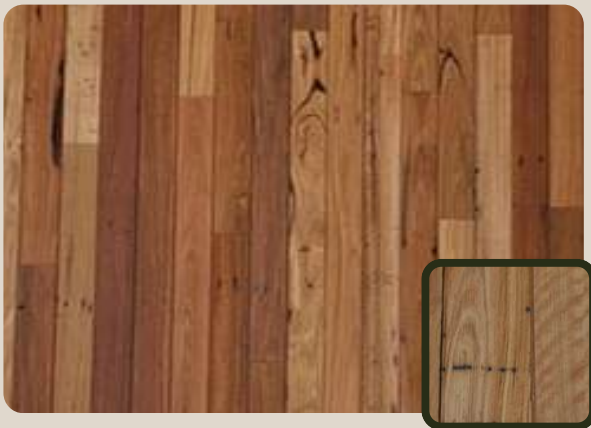


Recycled Rustic Wirebrushed Lining Boards

captures the true rustic character of recycled hardwood. Using the natural face of recycled timbers — predominantly old roofing purlins — each board reflects decades of weathering, preserving the marks and texture of its past life. Once de-steelled, the timber is wire brushed to enhance its raw, aged appeal, then profiled into lining boards. Every board is unique, rich in grain, patina, and natural imperfections. The result is character-filled timber panelling, ideal for feature walls, ceilings, and interiors seeking an authentic, timeless aesthetic.

Recycled Dressed Hardwood Lining Boards

a refined expression of recycled hardwood, focusing on a clean, dressed finish rather than the original rustic face. Crafted from recycled timbers — primarily old roofing purlins — each board is carefully machined to reveal the natural grain and colour. This dressed surface highlights the inherent beauty of the timber whilst expressing some of its history such as nail holes and gum veins. Every board is unique whilst still providing a more minimal, contemporary aesthetic. Ideal for oiling to enhance the colour, this option delivers a consistent, polished look without losing the depth and character of recycled material.

Using controlled flame, the surface of the timber is carefully charred to create a protective carbon layer, enhancing durability while delivering a distinctive, organic finish that cannot be replicated with paints or stains. This process not only preserves the timber for long-term performance but also reduces ongoing maintenance. The result is a striking, high-performance cladding solution suited to architectural exteriors seeking both resilience and visual impact.

The result is a character-rich cladding that showcases the natural grain of aged hardwood. It can be left to naturally silver off or oiled to maintain its rich tones, delivering durability with minimal ongoing maintenance.

The rough-sawn top face creates a lightly burnished texture, enhancing the depth and natural variation of aged Australian hardwood. Every board tells a story, making Dockside ideal for feature decks where the history of the timber is part of the design. Left to weather, the decking will naturally grey off over time, requiring minimal maintenance. The result is a premium, character-rich decking solution suited to both residential and commercial projects.

Recycled Turpentine Dressed All Round Decking

A clean, refined expression of recycled hardwood. Milled from recycled wharf pylons, boards may carry subtle signs of its past life, (iron staining) while maintaining a more consistent, architectural finish without bolt holes. Dressed on all four sides, Forma provides a smooth, precise profile suited to contemporary outdoor spaces. Naturally ranging from golden brown to deep reddish tones, the timber features a fine grain with occasional darker streaks for added depth. For longevity and to enhance its rich colour, we recommend regular application of a high-penetrating oil such as CD50.
